

Target Center Fundraiser

Last year, the school fundraiser brought in over \$12,000 dollars to the school. Of that \$12,000, \$8,300 was used as tuition payment of the families that participated within the fundraiser. The remaining balance went into the school's general fund. This fundraiser **can be** a major source of income to our school and parish.

Last year, Father Juettner opened up the fundraiser to include all those families within the parish. As you work, a percentage of income can go to the school tuition or the church youth program, with the remaining % going to the school's general fund. Events 1-15 you will receive 60%. Events 16-25 you will receive 70%. For all events above 25 you will receive 90%.

The income mentioned is never given to the worker rather sent directly to our Target Center Finance Coordinator. That person creates a spreadsheet showing the amount of money each worker earned per event from the check that is sent out by Aramark. (Aramark is the company that runs all the food & drink products throughout the Target Center.) Then submit's the totals to the school, so the proper accounts can be credited.

You can "Adopt a student", "Take Stock in our Youth", "Give to the School Building Fund" without opening up your checkbooks. Please consider taking part in this fundraiser. Think about how your time can benefit the school and parish youth .



What are the qualifications to work at the Target Center?

1. You must be 18 or older.
2. You attend training for serving alcohol. (Not demanded but helpful)
3. You can smile and be courteous.
